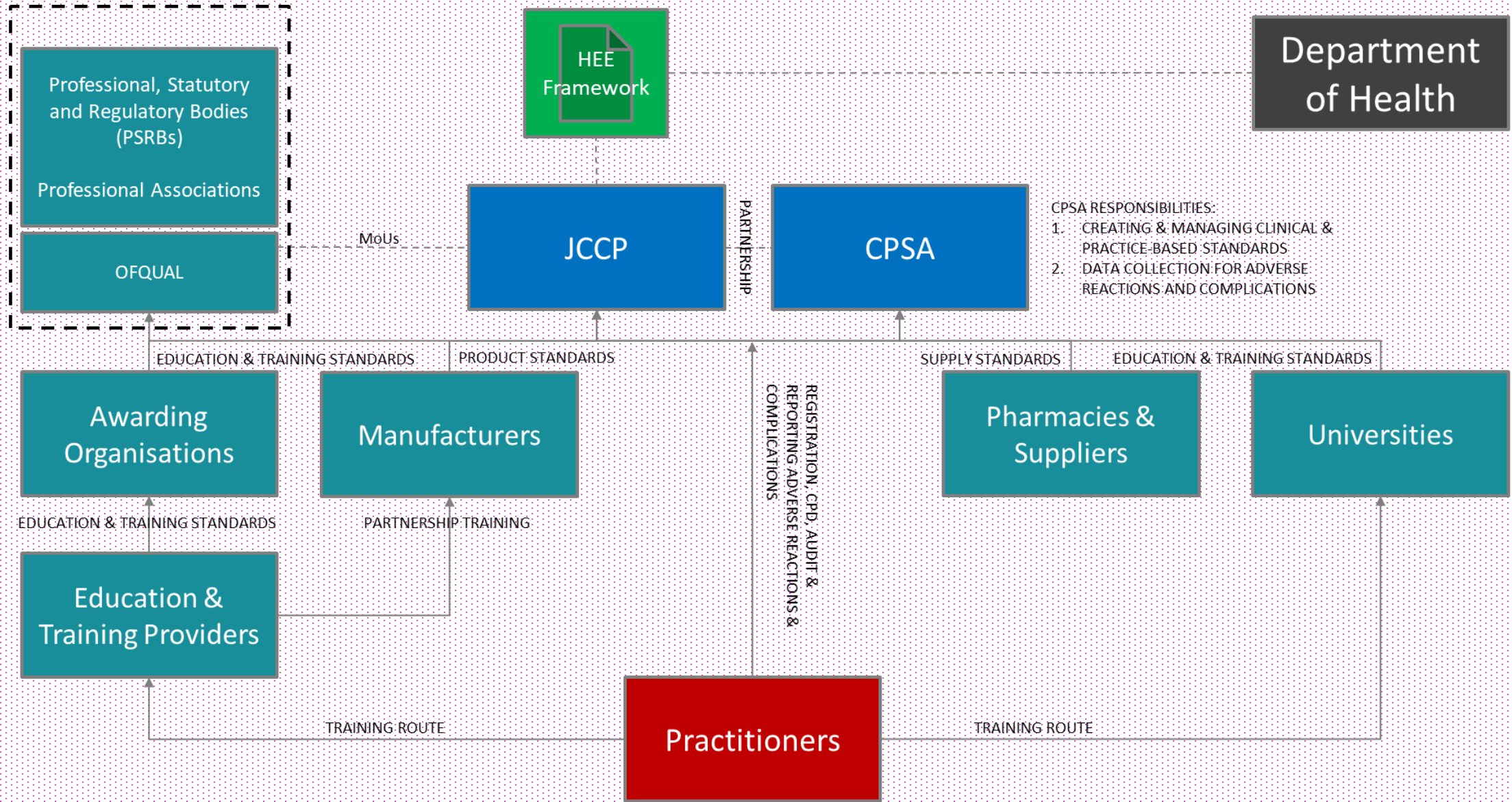

The JCCP Aspiration

“Seeking to become a ‘thoughtful organisation’ that encourages the pursuit of trustworthiness and effective collaboration amongst its partners in order to protect the public and to promote excellence in practice”

Key Functions of the JCCP

- Management of the JCCP Practitioner Register and JCCP Register of Approved Education and Training providers.
- Establishing a set of entry requirements for membership of the JCCP Registers.
- Establishing, managing and overseeing a 'Joint Code of Practice' with the CPSA for its members.
- Making the JCCP Registers available to the public in the interests of public protection.
- Maintaining an effective relationship with the CPSA and with the key Professional Governing Councils, Regulators and bodies involved in the aesthetics industry.

Key Functions of the CPSA

- Setting the standards for clinical and practice proficiency in non-surgical aesthetics.
- Collection of activity data, adverse event data, developing Patient Outcome Measures, Patient Experience Measures.
- Developing and leading on evidence based research.
- Scanning horizons for new orphan treatments and where appropriate updating the standards framework.
- Working with the JCCP and advising other regulatory bodies and Councils on standards with regard to non-surgical aesthetic treatments.

JCCP Update

- Status – Not for profit charitable body – application pending with the Charity Commission.
- Governance – Board of Trustees and Committees in place (FtP and Register - Education, Training and Accreditation) – FtP Appointment Panels – September/October 2017.
- PSA Accreditation – Application Submitted in July – result awaited.
- Practitioner Register.
- Approved Education and Training Provider Register.
- Technology Platform.
- Memoranda of Understanding Pending Confirmation– Key Partners – Ofqual, GMC and other PSRB's.

CPSA Update – Standard Setting

- CPSA Expert workshops held in August 2017 – Reviewed HEE framework and added clinical and practice based standards.
- September 2017 – CPSA publishes draft educational, clinical and practice standards for consultation.
- Supervision and oversight framework issued.
- October 2017 – Deadline for responses to draft standards.
- November 2017 – CPSA amends standards and approves.
- December 2017 – JCCP adopts the CPSA standards - uses to define entry requirements for its Practitioner Register and as a framework for education and training qualifications and provision.

JCCP Stakeholder Council - Introduction



The Stakeholder Council has been created by the JCCP Board of Trustees to provide the Board with advice, opinion, guidance and recommendations from a variety of informed perspectives about the operations of the JCCP in pursuit of its mission. The Council's members reflect diverse experiences, geographies and interests in relation to the work of the JCCP.

JCCP Stakeholder Council -Functions

To provide advice, support, recommendations and informed opinion to the JCCP Board of Trustees and Committees in the following areas:

- Policy development.
- Application of the JCCP/CPSA standards.
- The operation of the JCCP Registers, its work programme and capacity to achieve its strategic goals.
- The JCCP Strategic Plan.
- Communication channels with the various stakeholder constituencies and geographies represented on the Council.
- Raising public awareness of the issue of patient safety in aesthetics and the JCCP brand.
- Specific matters on which the Board of Trustees, Committees and/or the Executive requests advice.

JCCP Stakeholder Council - Structure

- The Council – up to 100 members
- Steering Group – up to 10 members
- Chair

JCCP Stakeholder Council – Steering Group

The Steering Group shall be composed of up to 10 members, plus the Chair, who are representative of diverse constituencies in the Stakeholder Council. Steering Group members shall serve a term of one year, and may be reappointed.

The Steering Group's duties shall include:

- a. Consultation with the full Stakeholder Council as needed between full meetings of the Council to develop policy advice on behalf of the Stakeholder Council.
- b. Meeting regularly to consider JCCP matters that may be relevant for consideration by the Stakeholder Council.
- c. Systematically communicating with and engaging with members of the Stakeholder Council to facilitate their active involvement in the JCCP's programme of work.
- d. Developing priorities and an annual work programme for the Stakeholder Council.
- f. Managing the nominations, selection and reappointment processes for Stakeholder Council members.

JCCP Stakeholder Council – Chair

- The Stakeholder Council shall appoint one Chairperson following an open call for nominations and a formal vote by members of the Stakeholder Council.
- Nominations and voting may be conducted electronically as needed.
- The Chair shall be appointed for a period of two (2) years.
- The Chair of the Stakeholder Council shall be a member of the JCCP Board of Trustees and shall be subject to appointment as a Trustee in accordance with Charity Commission procedural requirements.
- The Chair of the Stakeholder Council shall engage with Stakeholder Council members to determine issues that require consideration by the JCCP Board. The Stakeholder Council may also submit views directly to the Board of Trustees for consideration, subject to agreement by the JCCP Board Chair.

Next Steps

- 'JCCP/CPSA Confirmation of support' letter issued to all prospective Stakeholder Council members.
- Letters of support signed and returned.
- JCCP approves membership of Stakeholder Council and appoints temporary Chair.
- Stakeholder Council holds first meeting and agrees process for nomination to Steering Group and Election of Chair.
- Schedule of meetings agreed.
- Chair elected.
- JCCP informed of Chair nomination.
- JCCP confirm nomination.
